The Department of Classics and Archaeology at Loyola Marymount University is generating an applicant pool of qualified temporary instructors to teach courses in Classics, Classical Civilizations, Near Eastern Archaeology, and Egyptology should an opening arise. The pool will remain in place for two calendar years; those interested in remaining in the pool after the two years must reapply. Positions may range from 33% to 67% time, and may begin in the fall or spring of the new academic year.

We are especially interested in Egyptologists who can teach Egyptian Religion, and Classicists who can teach Greek and/or Latin. Additionally, candidates who can teach courses in Near Eastern Archaeology, Greek and Roman religions and Greek and Roman civilizations should apply.
