## Fellowship or prize amount: up to \$20,000

The fellowships and prizes are intended for those who hold a PhD degree by 1.10.2018 and up to three years after receiving their doctorate

Only candidates who have submitted their doctoral thesis by 31.12.2017 may apply

Applications can be made for a full year or half a year

The following documents are required:

1. Application form
2. Digital photograph
3. Cover letter to the Academic Committee
4. CV and a list of publications (in English)
5. Abstract of the research proposal, up to one page, double spaced (in English)
6. Detailed research proposal: definition of the study goals, details of the study methods, the stages of research, timetable, and the contribution which the study is expected to make (in English or Hebrew)
7. Copy of doctoral certificate or approval of the doctoral program
8. Two letters of recommendation
