

### **ASOR Harris Grants to Support Archaeological Field Projects**

ASOR expects to award a grant of \$5,000 in 2017 to support an ASOR-affiliated field project. The Harris Endowment provides modest grants to worthy field projects that are CAP-affiliated, particularly to newer and smaller projects, to help them get started; and to discrete components of larger projects that can be completed with an award. The Endowment also provides support for off-season research, analysis, and publications.

The application deadline is December 15, 2016. We hope to announce the successful application by January 15, 2017.
