

The Global Health Education and Learning Incubator (GHELI), jointly with the Derek Bok Center for Teaching and Learning, is seeking applicants for a **Global Health Pedagogy Fellow**. Applicants should have an interest in pedagogy and teaching methods, experience as a Teaching Fellow for undergraduate global or public health courses at Harvard, and be well-equipped to advise other Teaching Fellows throughout the school year.

The appointment will begin in August 2017 and continue through May 2018. Responsibilities include attending Bok Center trainings, working out of the GHELI office in Harvard Square for set hours each week, and providing support to the teaching staff of multiple global health courses taken by undergraduates. This support will come in a number of forms, including one-on-one meetings with Teaching Fellows to help them plan sections or review their work, facilitating practice teaching sessions, and holding lunches or workshops for Teaching Fellows in health courses.

Compensation will be equivalent to teaching one or two sections per semester at Harvard College.
