Faculty in Residence/ Lecturer

The College of Arts and Science at Oberlin College invites applications for the position of Faculty-in-Residence and Lecturer in the Jewish Studies program. This is a full-time, 10 month, live-in position.

The appointment will be made for either Spring (January) or Fall (August) semester 2017 and will have the possibility of renewal. The appointment will carry the rank of Lecturer.

The incumbent will teach courses in Modern Hebrew language and/or Jewish Cultural Studies. As Faculty-in-Residence in Hebrew Heritage House, a residence hall which houses approximately 28 students, s/he will design and implement programs for the campus community for the purpose of enhancing the understanding of Jewish experience and the varieties of Jewish expression through art, music, philosophy and literature. The incumbent is required to live at Hebrew Heritage House while the College is in session (September through May). Responsibilities also include supervising the student Program Director by providing direction, support, mentorship and constructive feedback.
