Noble Group Fellowships are available to Chinese citizens who are doctoral or post-doctoral candidates in any area within the interests of the Albright. Candidates can be either studying or in residence in China or doing research at institutions in other countries. The amount of \$51,000 is available for up to four awards with a maximum grant of \$25,000 for nine months and \$12,500 for 4.5 months from September 2017 - May 2018.

The fellowship covers room and half-board at the institute plus a stipend. Residence at the Albright is required during the fellowship year.
