Scholarships

Cyprus University Funds

The University of Cyprus offers a number of scholarships to postgraduate students from its own funds. Within this framework, there are two different frameworks for the scholarships submission: Internal Scholarships of the departments for postgraduate students from the income of their postgraduate fees

The various academic Departments of the University of Cyprus may offer scholarships to new students or to students already studying at the university. The scholarship is granted for one academic year and it could be a full scholarship (covering tuition fees and a lump sum), or partial (fees or lump sum). Scholarships are granted based on academic performance and the financial status of the students. The aim is to attract high level students. Interested students complete the relevant application form once scholarships have been announced.

Scholarships for overseas Cypriots and non EU citizens The University of Cyprus may offer scholarships for post-graduate studies at a Master and PhD levels to overseas Cypriots and citizens of non- EU countries. The aim of these scholarships is to develop relations between the University and overseas Cypriots as well as to attract students from other countries.

Assistantships

Apart from scholarships offered by the State, the University of Cyprus may subsidize a postgraduate student who offers to work as an assistant in covering the needs of his/her department or other departments. Assistantships may involve assisting in teaching, tutorials, help with assignments, lab supervision, grading, etc. They do not apply to the research activity of the student nor to the research activity of the academic and research staff. Monthly earnings can amount to EURO 342 or EURO 683 for a maximum period of ten months.
