The three-month Glassman Holland Fellowship is open to all European post-doctoral researchers who are permanently resident in Europe. The purpose is to give European scholars in the humanities an opportunity to broaden their knowledge of current research in Near Eastern Studies in Israel, to provide them with scholarly resources not available to them in their home institutions, and to offer them opportunities to interact with local and foreign scholars through the Albright's fellowship program. The fellowship award is \$12,000, covering room and half-board at the institute plus stipend.

The Albright Institute, the oldest American research center in the Middle East, provides an unparalleled international cultural environment and a unique program which spans the broad spectrum of Near Eastern studies from prehistory to the Islamic period. This includes the disciplines of archaeology, anthropology, art history, Bible, historical geography, history, ancient languages and literature, religion and related subjects.
