

Instructor (different positions) in Religious Studies, CAMNES Deadline September 30th 2017

The School of Religious Studies (SoRS) at CAMNES (Florence, Italy) is in the process of launching a new program in Religious Studies. We are searching for instructors to teach academic courses for both Florence and Rome undergraduate programs (contracts will be renewable at the end of every term) in the following fields: Christianity (Early and contemporaneous), Hagiography, Biblical Studies (Old and New Testament), History of Catholicism in Italy, and Mysticism. The courses (a total of eight, 5 in Florence and 3 in Rome) will be starting from September 1st 2018 (i.e., Fall semester 2018).

The courses follow a semester schedule (Fall and Spring) and will be taught in English. They will cover general introductory courses on the Bible (both the New and Old Testament), Christianity, Islam and mysticism for undergraduate students. A PhD in the above-mentioned fields is highly recommended.

The candidate will receive a salary according to her/his qualifications and a set reimbursement for traveling from neighboring Italian cities during the teaching period.

The selected candidates will be interviewed in English language via Skype.

Profile requirements:

Candidates must at least hold a degree of Master of Arts, or an equivalent degree, in Religious Studies/History/Theology.

Candidates must have command of the English language (i.e., a proficient level), both written and oral.

A PhD in the above-mentioned fields will be preferred.

Experiences with students in the field of Religious Studies are also desirable.
