We are particularly interested in a candidate with expertise in subjects that will appeal to students broadly interested in the Middle East region. The ideal candidate will actively participate in the expansion and innovation of the Hebrew program.

Ph.D. in relevant academic field; native or near-native command of Hebrew and English; and excellent record of teaching experience of undergraduates at the college level. Experience in coordinating programs highly desirable.
