Open call for candidates for an open rank (tenure-track or tenured) position in the archaeology of the Proto-Historic, Bronze and Iron Ages at the Department of Archaeology and Ancient Near East Studies, Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

Job requirements:

Comprehensive knowledge of the archaeology of the Levant in the Protohistoric, Bronze and Iron periods; knowledge of the cultural, historical and textual aspects relating to the above mentioned periods; wide familiarity with the material culture of the neighbouring regions; proven experience in archaeological fieldwork; desire and ability to lead major, interdisciplinary research projects; a preference for specialization in the archaeology of the Bronze periods. Candidates should be in possession of a doctoral degree in the archaeology of the Levant or a comparable specialization.

The primary language of instruction at the Hebrew University is Hebrew, but candidates not familiar with Hebrew will be given time to reach proficiency in Hebrew during the initial years of their appointment.

Qualified candidates will be invited for an interview.
