

The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Faculty of Humanities invites applications from outstanding candidates for an open rank (tenure-track or tenured) position in the field of:

Jewish Thought Medieval, Renaissance and Early Modern Kabbalah until the end of the sixteenth century

Job requirements:

Comprehensive knowledge of Kabbalistic literature in the Middle Ages, Renaissance and Early Modern Period in one or more of the following fields: Kabbalah in Provence and Spain, Kabbalah in Byzantium, Kabbalah in Italy, North African Kabbalah and Kabbalah in the Land of Israel.

Responsibilities include teaching required and elective courses in candidate's field(s) of specialization (at the B.A. and M.A. degree levels) and related disciplines. Successful candidates are expected to conduct independent and original research at the highest academic level, demonstrate academic leadership, apply for Israeli and international research grants, and cooperate with other researchers within the Faculty of Humanities and other Faculties. The primary language of instruction at the Hebrew University is Hebrew, but candidates not familiar with Hebrew will be given time to reach proficiency in Hebrew during the initial years of their appointment.

Qualified candidates will be invited for an interview. Only candidates with a Ph.D. will be considered
