201718 Postdoctoral Research Associate in Egyptology and Assyriology

The Department of Egyptology and Assyriology at Brown University invites applications for a Postdoctoral Research Associate in Egyptology or Assyriology (including the material culture of Egypt or Mesopotamia), or the history of the exact sciences in antiquity. Candidates whose research interests complement those of current faculty are particularly encouraged to apply. The successful candidate will be appointed for one year beginning on 1 July 2017, with the possibility of renewal for an additional year (201819). Postdoctoral Research Associates are expected to pursue their own research and publications and are required to teach an undergraduate level course one semester and a graduate level course the other. Postdoctoral Research Associates are also expected to participate in the academic life of the department: for example, by involvement in research seminars and counseling graduate students in their research. Applications for the 201718 appointment are due before January 16, 2017.
