

Lady Wallis Budge Junior Research Fellowship in Egyptology
Christ's College, Cambridge

Christ's College, Cambridge invites applications for a Junior Research Fellowship in Egyptology supported by the Lady Wallis Budge Fund. It will be tenable for four years from not later than 1 October 2016 and is not renewable.

Applications are invited from candidates who hold a first degree, or a higher degree, or who are studying for a higher degree. A Junior Research Fellowship is intended for a researcher early in their career and offers an opportunity to carry out novel research in a stimulating academic environment. Candidates should not hold or have held a stipendiary research fellowship at another Oxford or Cambridge College. The successful candidate is expected to be either a graduate student, probably in the latter stages of their research leading to a PhD Degree (or equivalent), or a post-doctoral researcher who has completed their PhD Degree after January 2014. Preference may be given to applicants who have completed less than 6 years of full-time research.
