Duties and Responsibilities

Applications are invited for a full-time Research Associate position to work with Dr Lily Kahn on the production of a comprehensive grammar of Maskilic (Jewish Enlightenment) Hebrew.

The responsibilities of the post will include selecting a representative corpus of Maskilic texts with the assistance of Dr Kahn; conducting an orthographic, morphological, syntactic, and lexical analysis of the corpus, in conjunction with Dr Kahn; and co-authoring a comprehensive reference grammar with Dr Kahn based on the analysis conducted. The postholder will also be expected to participate in departmental seminars and in national and international conferences.

Funding is available from the Leverhulme Trust until 31 August 2019 in the first instance.

Key Requirements

Candidates should hold a PhD or equivalent in Hebrew language and linguistics. Fluent knowledge of Hebrew and good knowledge of Yiddish are essential. Knowledge of other relevant languages, such as German, Russian, and Polish, is desirable.
