

At the Oriental Institute of the University of Vienna there will be a job vacancy in Archaeology and Art History for the period of absence of a member of staff. The contract will be for the short duration of 5.5 months only, starting from the 1st of March until 15th of August (i.e. Summer term).

The Institut für Orientalistik (conventionally: Department of Near Eastern Studies) has about thirty collaborator who mainly work in four fields of research and teaching: Ancient Near Eastern studies, Arabic studies, Islamic studies and Turkish (especially Ottoman) studies. In Ancient Near Eastern studies the main focus - third-party funded research included - lies on philological approaches, but archaeology is likewise well represented. Currently there are more than 500 students enrolled in the BA, MA, and PhD programmes of the Institute. The position is vacant for the period of absence of a member of staff.
