Taught primarily by Boston-area professionals, our course offerings change every semester and provide critical contexts for thinking about politics, popular culture, technology, law, social justice, business, ethics, and more.

Applicants are asked to design a course that promotes active learning and innovative approaches to the proposed topic.

Instructors are selected from a competitive pool. The total compensation for each course, whether individually or team-taught, is \$4,500.
