

## **University Lecturer in Biblical Studies (Old Testament Exegetics) LU, Center for Theology and Religious Studies (CTR)**

Tasks: In the position of university lecturer, duties are included in teaching, research and administration.

Teaching refers to courses at the undergraduate level and advanced level in bible studies. The lion's part of the teaching concerns the Old Testament exegetics, but some teaching in Biblical Studies with a New Testament focus on the basic level can be included. Teaching in Beginner Brebre is a key part. In addition, supervision and examination of degree programs in bible science are included. Ability to teach Swedish and English is a requirement.

The research is conducted individually and in cooperation with colleagues and postgraduate students in the subject. The employees are expected to actively contribute to the activities of the research seminar in the Old Testament exegetics.

Administration includes education-related tasks such as course planning and course evaluation. The employees are expected to participate in the institutional development work and, together with colleagues, develop the activities in bible science.

Qualifications: For the position of university lecturer in bible science, especially the Old Testament exegetics, a doctorate in the Old Testament exegetics or equivalent is required. Furthermore, documented scientific competence is required, expressed in the form of international publications, as well as acclaimed teaching experience in Biblical Studies.

Excellent ability to teach Biblical, Biblical and Frontier religions and cultural environments as well as the basic ability to teach New Testament Greek and experience of essay supervision are meritorious. Meritants are also able to receive external research grants.

Knowledge of the CTR's activities in general and the education in specialization Bible science in particular is meritorious. We attach great importance to personal suitability.
