

Senior Academic Position in Archaeology

The Department of Archaeology and Near Eastern Cultures of Tel Aviv University, Israel, invites applications for a senior academic tenure-track position stressing the Archaeology of the Bronze and Iron Age periods in the southern Levant, with an emphasis on Art, Symbolic expression and Iconography. The position will be effective as of October 2018.

Candidates should demonstrate extensive field experience in archaeological excavations and will be expected to initiate an archaeological field project within the first three years of the tenure track. Moreover, candidates are required to master the relevant methodological and theoretical background needed for conducting state of the art archaeological research as well as the study of art, symbolic expression and iconography of the relevant periods.

The position requires teaching in Hebrew and in English, and the ability to conduct independent research in the relevant field. Candidates must hold a Ph.D., or receive a Ph.D. before filling the position. Salary and conditions will conform to Tel Aviv University regulations. Appointment procedures will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of Tel Aviv University and are subject to the approval of the University authorities.
