

Job Description:

Bard College invites applications for a one-year position as Hebrew tutor. Candidates should possess the equivalent of a Bachelors degree (U.S.) with a good academic record. Masters degrees are highly desirable. Applicants must clearly demonstrate maturity, dependability, integrity and professionalism. Fluency in English is mandatory. Prior Teaching experience is preferred. Candidates are usually expected to teach conversation courses and offer tutorials to students of various levels. Tutors are expected to have 15 contact hours per week, and to serve as resource person in conversation groups, cultural representatives, coordinators of extracurricular activities, and supervisors of language tables.

Candidates should be enthusiastic about teaching, and should have a sincere interest in teaching Hebrew language and Israeli culture to American students. They should have leadership skills, the ability to motivate students, and the ability to relate to them in an emphatic manner. They should be able to work creatively and be self-reliant, but also be good team players who maintains excellent relationships with faculty, staff and students and other language tutors.

The stipend for this position is approximately \$5,500 plus all room and board and the opportunity to enroll in Bard classes for credit. The college also pays round trip flight costs (with some restrictions).
